- ※ Submission Guideline for Academic Credential Verification of Overseas University: Any documents written in a language other than Korean or English must be translated into Korean or English by a certified translator.
 - ① Apostille Convention Country: Submit the Certificate of Graduation and Transcript notarized by Apostille.
 - ② Other Countries (Not Apostille Convention Country): Submit the Certificate of Graduation and Transcript (as a proof of confirmation overseas educational establishment or consul confirmation) notarized by the embassy or consulate office of Korea in-country.
- ※ All documents must be submitted in original form. No documents will be returned. (We do not accept copies, scanned documents or documents sent by email.)
- ※ If you do not submit all documents by the deadline for the first and second application, you will be disqualified. (Please be careful not to submit incomplete or missing documents.)

■ Introduction of Studies

1. Theology

Pursuing the mission of Yemyung Graduate University, the Division of Theology was established to prepare a global pastor, missionary, theologian, and church leader in a rapidly changing situation of the contemporary church. The Division of Theology provides students the opportunity to explore and formulate constructive insights in advanced theological study, including the course of M.Div. for the practice of ministry or missionary and the course of Th.M./Ph.D. in a particular area of <Biblical Theology>, <Theoretical Theology>, <Practical Theology>, <Missiology>, <Church Music>, and <Jesusonoma Theology>. With a variety of concentrations, the vocation of the Division of Theology is to foster professional Christian leaders with a talent of intelligence, spirituality, and sensibility embodied and implemented in evangelical theology.

2. Leadership

The Division of Leadership of Yemyung Graduate University aims to facilitate the development of students who can be committed to impactful and inclusive leadership for a rapidly changing world of globalization. As the nation's first-ever graduate school of leadership studies, the Leadership Division provides an outstanding curriculum that not only investigates the theory and practice of leadership, but also cultivates professional leadership on a in-depth level.
